4.10 The Secretary General informed the house that FEI General Assembly 2013 is scheduled to be held at Baku (Azerbaijan) from 11 - 14 Dec 2014. The same will be attended by the President and Secretary General.

- 4.11 The Secretary General informed the house that EDFZ has established at RVC Centre & College, Meerut and approved by the following for 17th Asian Games:-

- 4.15 <u>Court Cases.</u> The Secretary General informed the house that there is no Court case pending against the Federation as on date.
- 4.16 <u>Amendment to Technical Guidelines 2013.</u> The Secretary General informed the house that NEC Prelim Dressage Test has been made equivalent to FEI Prelim Test as agreed unanimously in EC meeting. The house also agreed to include water jump in NEC Gd III, II & I from next Calender onwards.
- 5. <u>Agenda III Passing of Accounts.</u> The accounts were passed after being proposed and seconded by Col Sarpartap Singh (Retd) and Col SS Solanki (Retd) respectively.
- 6. <u>Agenda IV Approval of proposed Annual Expenditure</u>. The proposed budget as attached at **Appx 'A'** to this minutes was passed after being proposed and seconded by Brig GS Puri and Mr Inderjit Singh respectively.
- 7. <u>Agenda V Approval of Calendar of Events 2014-15</u>. The Secretary General informed the house about the Tentative Calendar of events for the year 2014-15:-
 - 7.1 Lt Col Vivek Rehni requested that the dates for AEC may be postponed by one week, keeping in view the passing out parade in NDA. The proposal was agreed to unanimously.
 - 7.2 Lt Col Rohit Dagar proposed that the FEI world Challenge Jumping should be held at one venue only as this contributes points to rider for selection of Indian Team. He further stated that no similar ground conditions are possible at two different venues and the competition held later renders the rider at an disadvantage.
 - 7.3 Col Sarpartap Singh (Retd), Lt Gen Balbir Singh Sandhu, VSM, Vice President (Tech) and President EFI emphasized the stress of long travel for horses and expenditure on travel, was the reason the event was proposed to be at two different places. The president assured the house that all efforts will be done to ensure that the ground conditions in two venues are exactly the same.
 - 7.4 Mr BVP Rao & Asst Comd Dabar stated that the expenditure on long distance travel is unaffordable by civilian riders and this will give a disadvantage to them. Mr BVP Rao further stated that the FEI should actually split FEI Jumping in four zones instead of two.
 - 7.5 Lt Gen Balbir Singh Sandhu, VSM, Vice President (Tech) informed the house that the discussion to split FEI Jumping has been taken recently and we must continue this system for few more years before a rethink on one venue . President EFI supported the contention and agreed with Mr BVP Rao to further split it in four zones to reduce the travelling stress on horses/huge expenses of travel.
 - 7.6 Col SS Ahlawat, VSM stated that this year the venue should be reversed to give equal opportunity to both zones.

- 7.7 The house agreed to continue with the present system of two venues and reversal of venue in this Calender.
- 7.8 Mrs Gita Singh, Secretary Chhattisgarh Equestrian Academy requested that the event proposed by EC to be allotted to them clashes with the FEI World Jumping, which is likely to reduce participation in her Show. The house agreed that FEI World Jumping be postponed by few days to address her concern. The house finally approved the Calender for 2014-15 as attached at **Appx 'B'**.
- 8. Agenda VI Amendments in Statutes: The Secretary General briefed the house about the directions issued by MYAS on changing the statutes. Secy Gen informed the house that the point was avidly discussed in EC meeting and a unanimous consensus was reached to continue with our present statutes and Govt guidelines as applicable be followed. The house agreed to EC discussion.
- 9. <u>Agenda VII New Memberships</u>. 59 Life Members, 22 Individual Members, 10 Club Members, 01 Association Member and 13 unit members have been approved. Details are as **Appx** 'C'. The house unanimously agreed to membership approval as per the discussion of the EC.

10. Agenda VIII - Points Received from Members.

- 10.1 Col Dhumal proposed that name of the horse should also be flashed with the rider when results are displayed. The house agreed unanimously for the proposal.
- 10.2 Lt Col Rohit Dagar suggested that the penalty restrictions on giving National Medal should be removed as it is discouraging. To encourage more riders to upgrade their horses, this practice must be stopped. Vice President (Tech) informed the house that this decision was taken after long and detailed discussion and must stay as such. He further stressed that to improve the standard of jumping horizontally and vertically, this restriction must stay as such. He was supported that Brig G Puri and President EFI. Vice President (Tech) assured Lt Col Rohit Dagar and the house that the point will again be deliberated in next EC meeting and if required the number of penalties will be increased towards National Championships.
- 10.3 Lt Col Rohit Dagar further proposed that all Selection Committee Members must have a Individual National Medal to be eligible for the post. The house agreed to the proposal unanimously.
- 10.4 Lt Col Rohit Dagar pointed out that Jumping & Dressage International Shows have not been held in the country for a long time. Vice President (Tech) assured him that this Calender year we will try to organize an International Jumping/Dressage show in Delhi.
- 10.5 Representative of All India Police Sports Control Board and Asst Comdt Dabar requested that a Police representative be included in the EC as police is one of the biggest holders of horses in the country. Secy Gen informed the house that EC is a elected body and the President in his capacity can invite a Police representative in the EC meetings. Vice President (Tech) informed the house that a representative of police will be invited in next EC onwards and simultaneously the task of including them in EC will be taken up by Secy Gen.

- 10.6 The representative of Police Sports Control Board requested that the Police should also be included in all workshops conducted by EFI. Secy Gen informed him that all info is on the website and they are most welcome to take advantage of all activities of EFI.
- 10.7 Cor D Bali suggested that the penalty restriction on Jumping Grade I winner must be increased from the present 24 to minimum 32. Vice President (Devp) and Vice President (Tech) assured him that the same will be done in next EC.
- 10.8 Col Sarpartap Singh (Retd) informed that at present National medal is only awarded for lance events and suggested that sword events must also be included in National medal category. Col SS Solanki (Retd) supported the suggestion.
- 10.9 Mr BVP Rao stated that EFI has not made enough efforts to promote Tent Pegging in the country. He suggested that a Committee should be constituted to look into this aspect. Vice President (Tech) endorsed his views and decision was taken to constitute a committee for promotion of Tent Pegging in the country. Mr BVP Rao suggested the names of Mr Manoj Jalan, Col R Brar (Retd), Brig IS Lanba (Retd) and self to be part of this committee.
- 10.10 Mr Raghendra Singh pointed out that the increase in Annual Subscription for State Association is too steep and should be reduced. He further pointed out that the State Association must be taken on board on all matters pertaining to Equestrian promotion/organizing in the country. He gave few examples of Rajasthan Equestrian Sports body wherein the deserving Equestrian Sportsperson could not be awarded the cash incentives due to not taking the State Association on board in the conduct of the event. Vice President (Tech) assured that in next EC a detailed holistic view on the subject will be taken to set aside such anomalies.
- 10.11 Lt Col Rohit Dagar informed the house about the omission of Equestrian in the forthcoming National Games at Kerala. Secy Gen informed him that all out efforts are undertaken by the NF to get it included. Mr BVP Rao stated that there is no Equestrian Association in Kerala so we must take up a case from Federation side to get it organized at some other close by venue like Bangalore.
- 11. <u>Vote of Thanks</u>. In the end, a vote of thanks for outgoing EC Members was proposed and recommended by Col Tarsem Singh and Col D Bali respectively. The President also thanked the outgoing EC members.

12. <u>Presidents Conclusion</u>:-

- 12.1 He thanked all present for taking part enthusiastically in this AGM.
- 12.2 He stated that there is too much politics in Equestrian sports and that is the reason the sport has not improved as much as it should have. All Equestrian Sportsperson should concentrate on working hard to bring laurels to self and country.

- 12.3 He emphasized that Equestrian is a very Royal Game and you all are fortunate enough to be pursuing it. He appealed to all to give a large media exposure to further popularize the sport in the country.
- 12.4 He informed the house that all the Teams for the Asian Games have been selected on merit under complete transparency.
- 12.5 He appealed that more publicity to this beautiful game must be ensured and we must recommend our eminent sportsperson for various awards to the Govt.
