3. Dr SY Quraishi, learned Observer appointed by the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi was also present in the EC.

4. In terms of provisions as contained in Para 7 of Article 017, Chapter VI, the Secretary General proposed in the EC to nominate Lt Gen PR Venkatesh, PVSM, SM, Vice President (Vet) to chair the meeting. The EC approved the proposal.

5. **Opening Address by the nominated Chair.** The nominated chair of the meeting Lt Gen PR Venkatesh, PVSM, VSM welcomed all members to the EC Meeting. He said that COVID has compelled everyone to make several changes in the way things are perceived and various challenges undertaken with several restrictions on travel and gatherings which has actually led to this inordinate delay on the EC panel. There are several senior members located at various parts to the country for whom travel during this period was neither feasible nor advisable. Today certain states see a rise in COVID cases indicating a second wave, and one has to be cautious. Despite challenges faced, post COVID restrictions, the Federation has been able to kick start the equestrian calendar and conduct a number of events including FEI Dressage World Challenge, FEI Jumping World Challenge, FEI Eventing, NEC and JNEC. All the events conducted during post COVID period have been incident free with no COVID case reported during the events. He applauded the EFI Secretariat and the entire team of officials, Organising Committees and the brave Athletes who came forward to make each of these events a success. The NSDCI 2011 till recently did not have any provisions of relaxation in respect of compliance of the code by the NF. The ministry has introduced a clause in the NSDCI 2011 based on which exemption can be granted to NSFs pertaining to compliance of any provisions of the code. In addition to this, MYAS has granted EFI the annual recognition valid upto Nov 2021. He requested all honourable members to contribute meaningfully in this long awaited meet and requested each one to respect the views of other fellow members during the proceedings. Thereafter the nominated Chair of meeting requested the Secretary General to proceed with the agenda.

7. <u>SECRETARY GENERAL's BRIEFING</u>			
7.1 <u>EFI Calendar 2020-21.</u> The Secy Gen flashed the EFI Calendar 2020-21 attached as Appendix 'B' . He apprised the house that the Calendar was prepared after due diligence and accordingly tournaments were conducted. However, prior to start of events calendar, the Federation prepared a comprehensive COVID 19 Protocol for resumption of Training and Equestrian activities in which all Govt, FEI & WHO guidelines were incorporated which was passed by the Members of EC on email and was promulgated accordingly for conduct of	The house perused the same. <p>events. The biggest advantage of equestrian sport was that it is a non contact sport and held in open areas. The NF has ensured that sporting events were held for the benefit of athletes and thus the sport nor the athletes suffered in any way. Equestrian sport was peculiar and OCs took full precautions to ensure COVID 19 Protocols are followed by providing mask, sanitizer etc. The silver lining during the conduct of competitions was that not even a single case of COVID was reported during any event which was appreciated by the Ministry of Sports. The Secy Gen informed the house that equestrian sport has an inbuilt grievance mechanism as per Para 161 of FEI General Regulations wherein an individual can protest. He/She has to give an application to the OC and submit Rs 2000/- rupees and thereafter immediately the complaint is put up to the President Ground Jury by the OC. But there are timelines, which warrant protests to be filed within 30 minutes of the announcement of results. However, if someone writes after a year, it is infructuous because the duty of the Jury ceases 30 Minutes after the announcement of the results being 'Functus Officio'.</p> <p>The Secy Gen also informed the house that in NEC/JNEC 40 KM held at Sagar Equestrian Sports Academy, Jaipur wef 26 – 27 Feb 2021. There was an issue about the results and the same has been resolved as per existing procedures for the same. Jt Secy further clarified the matter to the house that there was some representation from the environment regarding the results of the event which were then sent to the Jury. There were minor changes but the first four positions remained the same. So the results were validated and then intimated to the environment and the matter has been settled. Jt Secy further added that Mr Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod was not a participant but on behalf of certain participants he had made some representations which were considered.</p>

<p>However, Mr Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod has made several false allegations pertaining to the event. The results were re-validated by the Jury based on available official videography and reports. The Secy Gen further informed the house that the moment an observation was raised regarding the event, results were withheld and only published after re-validation by the Jury and Technical Committee consisting of Member Discipline and Vice President (Tech). The organiser also confirmed that this individual was present during the tabulation of results. After announcement of the results, Mr Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod forwarded a complaint to the NF the next day.</p> <p>The Secy Gen informed the house that the NEC Tent Pegging 2020-21 was to be scheduled to be held from 01 to 07 Mar 2021 at Greater Noida organised by Equiwings Sports at the time of EC meeting. Thereafter, it was to be followed by World Cup Tent Pegging Qualifier of Group B countries. The countries will arrive in India on 10th Mar 2021. As of now there would be five countries which are likely to participate namely USA, Pakistan, Belarus, India and Qatar. All the paper work is in progress and hopefully India will host the qualifier on borrowed horses. He further added that on 8th, 9th & 10th Mar 2021 trials will be conducted for selection of the Indian Team for World Cup Qualifier as per the criteria laid down in the Technical Guidelines Tent Pegging 2021. On 08th & 09th Mar 2021 a Clinic was also planned for national level officials for Tent Pegging since for Tent Pegging discipline we need to increase the number officials as the existing number do not suffice the requirement for conduct of RELs/Regional/NEC competitions. This Clinic has been instrumental purely because of the dedicated efforts of the Member Discipline.</p> <p>The Secy Gen also apprised the house that the NF would be conducting a Coaching Camp for Eventing at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore prior to the NEC Eventing 2020-21 and for Show Jumping at ARG Stables, Chhatarpur (Delhi) prior to Delhi Horse Show 2021. The EC has already accorded their concurrence on email for both the Coaching Camps.</p>

<p>7.2 Results of Events:- The Secretary General presented the results of events held wef 01 Nov 2020 to till date. Results are attached at Appendix 'C'. While flashing the results of EFI Eventing CCN held at RVC Centre & College, Meerut wef 14 to 21 Jan 2021, the Secy Gen apprised the house that wef 01 Jan 2021, FEI has mandated the use of frangible devices to organise FEI Eventing events for one star and above categories. Due to ongoing COVID 19 pandemic EFI was not able to procure frangible devices from abroad as they were not available in India. May be during the next couple of months EFI should be able to procure them. Thereafter EFI will again revert back to CCI events because conduct of these events may very important in view of the Asian Games Selection Trials which is going to take place from third quarter of 2021.</p> <p>He also added that NEC Show Jumping was a big success this year. Last year it was held in Kolkata and there were only 43 entries in total and this year EFI had 210 entries despite COVID 19 pandemic. Last year in Kolkata there were no entries for Grade II and there was only one entry for Grade I and Grand Prix. This year EFI has substantial entries in Grade II, I & Grand Prix categories.</p>	The house perused the results of all events.	Secy Gen	
<p>7.3 Annual General Body Meeting (AGM). The Secy Gen informed the house that Annual General Body Meeting for the year 2020 was scheduled to be held on 21st Mar 2021 at DSOI, Delhi Cantt. The AGM got delayed due to outbreak of COVID 19 pandemic and restrictions thereof.</p>	The house approved the same.	Secy Gen	
<p>7.4 Selection Criteria for 19th Asian Games. The Secy Gen informed the house that the Selection Criteria for 19th Asian Games 2022, Hangzhou, China is being finalised. He also added that the level of competitions will be decided in upcoming AEF General Assembly 2021 which as of now will be held in May 2021.</p>	The house perused the same. <p>7.5 <u>International Tent Pegging Federation General Assembly 2020.</u> The Secy Gen informed the house that the ITPF is holding its General Assembly 2020 on 09 Mar 2021. Earlier it was scheduled to be held physically, but just few days ago the ITPF has informed that the General Assembly will be held virtually. <p>7.6 <u>Inclusion of relaxation provision in NSDCI-2011 by MYAS.</u> The Secy Gen apprised the house that the Equestrian is a peculiar sport and there were certain issues related to the NSDCI 2011 which as on date the Federation was unable to comply. He flashed the relaxation clause which the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has included in the NSDCI 2011 and promulgated on 01 Feb 2021 wherein it is regulated that the Minister In-Charge of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports is empowered to give relaxation to NSFs wrt NSDCI 2011. He also informed the house that the case of EFI is already with the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and they will be taking a call whenever they deem fit.</p>	The house perused the same. <p>7.7. <u>Waiver of Import Duty on Horses for Equestrian Sports : Letter of Recommendation by MYAS</u> The Secy Gen informed that for the past few years EFI has been taking up the case with the Ministry of Finance for abolition of Customs Duty for import of horses for Equestrian sports. Due to continuous persuasion by the NF, the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has now again taken up a case with Ministry of Finance vide their letter No F 27-1/2016-SP-III dt 22 Feb 2021 to waive off the customs duty on import of horses for Equestrian sports. Hopefully soon EFI should get this case through with Ministry of Finance. Col SS Ahlawat, VSM (Retd), Member Dressage said that the Race Horses are already enjoying the benefit of customs duty exemption. The nominated Chair of the meeting appreciated the efforts and said that this will be a big game changer for development of the equestrian sport in India.</p>	The EC praised the efforts.	Secy Gen

<p>7.8. <u>Audit of Institutional/ Clubs/Units by Committee.</u> The Secy Gen informed the house that there were a lot of Institution/Club/Units which were not taking part in the equestrian activities. The EC therefore formed a Committee to carry out an audit of all registered Institution/Club/Units. The summary of audit report alongwith the details of membership clubs/units/ institutions to be terminated were flashed. The summary of audit is attached as Appendix D. The nominated Chair of the meeting said that this was a long sore point that the membership of clubs which do not have any equestrian activities should be terminated. The Secy Gen informed the house that when EFI was not a very financially sound org, these Institution/Club/Units whose membership are being proposed to be terminated, provided the financial support to the Federation through their regular subscription despite their meager financial resources to enable EFI to reach where it is today. The Federation was formed by one of the biggest stakeholder of the sport i.e Indian Army and the EFI would like to thank them. He further highlighted about the veterinary hospitals which took care of vet needs of the horses and provide vet cover for all the shows, free of cost including medicines irrespective of the owner of horses (it could be private / government / club etc) The efforts of these silent warriors who have provided unstinted support to EFI should be appreciated.</p>	The EC perused the same and in agreement with the recommendation of the audit committee. <p>7.9 <u>Hiring of Sports Public Relations (PR) Agency.</u> The Secy Gen apprised the house about the urgent need for hiring a Sports PR Agency. Strong media relationships were important in sports PR because they help generate understanding, acceptance and communication between the public and the sports organizations, athletes, stakeholders etc. He said that every year EFI was allocating certain amount of funds for publicity but they are not utilised. Dr Sanjay Gupta, Regional Member (Central) suggested that EFI should hire PR Agency for a year as a pilot project.</p>	The house agreed to the suggestion of Secy Gen and recommended to proceed further to hire a PR Agency. <p>7.10 <u>Legal Matters.</u> The Secretary General informed the EC about the present status of various legal matters.</p> <p>He apprised the house about the case of REA vs EFI that the last hearing was on 10 Feb 2021 but on 09 Feb 2021 there was a report filed by the learned Observer because of which EFI got another date of hearing i.e 03 Mar 2021.</p> <p>He also informed the house about the Writ Petition filed by Ms Raquel Shefali Fernandez vs EFI regarding participation of OCI Card holder in JNEC 2020-21. Ms Raquel Shefali Fernandez, a 10 years old child whose parents were of different nationality (Father is Indian and mother is from Belgium) and holding passport of Belgium. The girl was an OCI Card holder and wanted to participate in Junior National Equestrian Championship (JNEC) 2020 as normal entry. The NF had conveyed that she wasn't eligible to participate in the JNEC since this event was for Indian Citizens only but she can participate as an HC entry. She refused to participate in JNEC as an HC entry and filed a petition in Hon'ble Delhi High Court. The hon'ble Judge of Delhi High Court issued an order that she can participate in JNEC as HC entry only. The court also issued notice to MEA, MHA & MYAS for their comments and next date of hearing was on 25 Mar 2021.</p>	The house perused the existing cases.	Secy Gen	
<p>7.11 <u>Annual Calendar for Training and Competition : 2020-2021</u></p> <p>The Secy Gen informed the house that post receipt of recognition from Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) on 26 Nov 2020, EFI applied for ACTC 2020-21 with the Ministry. On 17th Dec 2020 EFI had a meeting with the Secy of Sports and other members of MYAS and Sports Authority of India (SAI) during which an amount of Rs 1,06,08,200/- (Rupees One Crore Six Lac Eight Thousand Two Hundred only) were approved for EFI under ACTC. Till date EFI is in receipt of Administrative Sanction for Rs 99,95,0000/- (Rupees Ninety Nine Lac Ninety Five Thousand only) from Sports Authority of India for various Coaching Camps, National & International</p>	The house perused the same. events including procurement of equipments like Show Jumping Set, Timer Machine, Safety Cups, Frangible Devices etc. He also informed the house that the remaining amount of Rs 6,13,200/- may be surrendered as the same was projected for AEF Young Riders (YRs) Show Jumping & Dressage final and FEI Jumping World Challenge final which have been postponed / cancelled by the Organiser.			
7.12 Annual Calendar for Training and Competition : 2020-2021 The Secy Gen flashed the details of ACTC projection for the year 2021-22. Col SS Ahlawat, VSM (Retd), Member Dressage said that Selection Trials, Coaching Camp of Probables abroad etc needs to be included in the ACTC. The Secy Gen replied that the ACTC 2021-22 included the Selection Trials of all three disciplines. However, as regards to the Foreign Exposure of Asian Games probables abroad, the same will be included in the projection of ACTC for year 2022-23 as the foreign exposure will happen after 31 Mar 2022 and only be considered in next financial year on the advice of SAI/MYAS. Col Tarsem Singh Warraich, Member Tent Pegging suggested that EFI needs to conduct ITPF Tent Pegging Course for Indian officials. The Secy Gen replied that EFI will try to factor in the ACTC for 2021-22. He also said that final discussion with SAI and the MYAS is likely to be held in Mar 2021 for which they will intimate date and time to the Secretariat.	The house perused the same.	Secy Gen	
7.13 Infrastructure Development & Procurement of Tangible Assets. The Secy Gen informed the house that EFI needs to buy certain equipments from its funds otherwise they have to pay a substantial amount of tax. The last date of 5 years circle is ending on 31 Mar 2021. EFI is still trying to get an extension from Income Tax authorities because of the COVID but it is unlikely to come through. So the EC has to accord permission to start the tendering process so that we are ready by 21 Mar 2021 for approval at the AGM 2020. <p>the proposal is cleared in the AGM 2020 EFI can place supply order. Most of the items which are proposed to be procured are from foreign based companies which follow FEI specification. These foreign company's policy is that they need complete payment prior to shipping of equipment. Col SS Ahlawat, VSM (Retd) said that Water Jump should be included in the Show Jumping Set. The Secy Gen replied that the same is included. The Jt Secy informed the house that under the IT Act Section 11 (2) any accumulated fund that EFI accrues and shows as funds generated, one can get an exemption on the Income Tax but provided the amount is spent within a cycle of 5 years. So the first installment of money i.e Rs 1,20,00,000/- declared to the IT Department during FY 2015-16 is due for expenditure by 31 Mar 2021. Due to certain reasons like the pandemic the EC and AGM got delayed so this money could not be spent. If EFI doesn't spend this money, they have to pay a tax of 30% straight away alongwith the penalty thereof which will amount to about 40% on the total amount which will be roughly 48 Lacs. The Jt Secy brought out that FEI approved Timing Device, Safety Devices and Show Jumping sets can be procured from abroad, but payment to these foreign firms have to be made in advance. This has to be approved by EC. Also these are well established companies. Col Tarsem Singh, Member Tent Pegging suggested EFI should procure FEI approved equipment as the quality is good.</p>			
<p>7.14 <u>Payment to EFI Officials : National / International Events in India.</u> The Secy Gen informed the house that in the past, the expenses towards travel, boarding & lodging, local transportation, remuneration etc in respect of officials detailed by EFI for various National/International events was borne by the Organiser. The serving officers who are posted/available at the location of OC's holding events and are not provided temporary duty by their org may be provided assistance akin to the rates of local tpt only. <p>7.15. <u>Corpus Money : FEI World Challenge.</u> The Secy Gen informed the house that when the bid form for EFI events was reviewed from the OC, Corpus Money for all bids were refundable except for FEI World Challenge and FEI Children's Classics which were conducted under solidarity programme of FEI. He proposed that this Corpus Money should also be refundable. Col SS Ahlawat, VSM (Retd), Member Dressage queried about the entry fees of events. 10.1 <u>Col Rajesh Pattu, SJRP, VSM (Retd).</u> The Secy Gen informed the house that when the mail for EC Meeting was circulated on 08 Feb 2021, the Athletes' Commission was asked for points by 19 Feb 2021 for further circulation to EC Members. There being no mail received from Athletes' Commission by 19 Feb 2021, the Secy Gen spoke with Chairperson Athletes' Commission on 21 Feb 2021 who clarified that there were no points from Athletes for discussion in the forthcoming EC Meeting. Col SS Ahlawat, VSM (Retd), Member Dressage requested the house to excuse the reps of Athletes' Commission before discussing the email of Col R Pattu & its reminders thereof. The Chairperson, Athletes' Commission agreed that since none of the points raised by Col R Pattu were related to Athletes as they are pertaining to the administration of EFI. However, she requested that a suitable reply be given to him on his mails. Lt Gen PR Venkatesh, PVSM, SM, nominated chair of the meeting assured that each of his points will be discussed and based on the views of majority of members, a suitable reply will be forwarded to him. Thereafter, the Chairperson & Vice Chairperson, Athletes' Commission left the room on the request of the Secy Gen to enable EC to discuss and deliberate on his email and reply thereof.	The EC discussed each and every point of email dated 01 Jun 2021 and reminders thereafter by Col R Pattu bearing LM 153 and prepared a draft reply. The EC alongwith the Hon'ble Observer appointed by Hon'ble Delhi High Court Dr SY Quraishi who was in attendance found the activities of Col Rajesh Pattu contrary to the objectives and interest of the EFI as stipulated in the EFI Statutes. At the end, the Dispute Resolution and Discipline Committee's opinion on his emails were also discussed. The EC, in the presence of Hon'ble Delhi High Court appointed learned Observer unanimously decided to take action in terms of Para 4 and 7 of Article 007, Chapter II of EFI Statutes.	Secy Gen

<p>12. <u>Closing Address by the nominated Chair of the Meeting.</u> Lt Gen PR Venkatesh, PVSM, SM thanked Dr SY Quraishi, learned Observer and each EC Members including members the Athletes Commission for taking out their precious time out of their busy schedule to come and attend the EC meeting which has taken place after a long gap despite many options to stay away due to either prior commitments or the prevailing COVID 19 scenario throughout the country. However, as a collective body fulfilling the minimum quorum of 07 members, EFI has been able to take a number of constructive decisions which will help in streamlining the functioning of the Federation and paving the path for conduct of the AGM scheduled next month. Despite the COVID 19 pandemic, the restrictions imposed thereon and the gradual unlocking phases has not diminished the passion for sports and the same is substantiated by the overwhelming participation at the various events and competitions conducted by the Federation. Equestrian sport being a non-contact sport were amongst the few to have conducted the Junior Nationals and the Senior Nationals post COVID 19 restrictions and that too without major issues. This itself speaks in volumes for the organisation and the entities associated with it. He once again thanked each one for contributing to the cause of the organisation and looked forward to the unstinted support rendered so far in making the organisation and the sport a clean and transparent one. He wished each one good health and safety.</p>

For the Financial year ended 31st March 2020.1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIESa. **Basis of preparation:**

The financial statement are prepared under the historical cost convention on the accrual basis in accordance With Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) in India, and materially comply with accounting standards issued by ICAI and the provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961.

b. **Use of Estimates:**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with GAAP requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities and the reported amount of revenues and expenses during the period. Actual results may differ from these estimate.

c. **Revenue Recognition:**

Revenue are recognised as under:

- a) Revenue with respect to subscription, Grants and corpus money is recognized as due.
- b) Interest is recognized on accrual basis.
- c) Dividends is recogized when right to receive are established.

d. **Fixed Assets:**

Fixed Assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Costs include cost of acquisition and all other attributable cost for bringing the asset to its working condition for its intended use. The assets are capitalized from the date when they are ready to put to use.

e. **Depreciation:**

Depreciation is provided on a WDV method at the rates specified in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

f. **Inventories:**

Stocks are valued on FIFO basis and are stated at lower of cost or net realizable value.

g. **Investments:**

Long term investments are stated at cost, after providing for diminution in their carrying vaiues, if any, other than of temporary nature. Current investments are carried at lower of cost or fair value on individual investment basis.

h. **Taxation:**

The current charge for income Tax is calculated in accordance with the relevant tax regulations applicable to the Federation.



i. **Impairment of Assets**

The Federation at each balance sheet date whether there is any indication that an asset may be impaired. If Any such indication exists, the Federation estimates the recoverable amount of the asset. If such recoverable amount of the asset or the recoverable amount of the cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs is less than its carrying amount, the carrying amount is reduced to its recoverable amount. The reduction is treated as an impairment loss and is recognized in the Income and Expenditure account.

j. **Provisions**

A provision is recognized when:

- i. the Federation has a present obligation as a result of past event;
- ii. it is probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation; and
- iii. a reliable estimate can be made of the amount of the obligation.

Provisions are not discounted to its present value and are determined based on best estimate required to settle the obligation at the balance sheet date. These are reviewed at each balance sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current best estimates.

2-Notes to Accounts:

- 1-Previous year's figures have been regrouped, rearranged and re-casted wherever considered necessary.

2-CONTINGENT LIABILITIES NOT PROVIDED FOR:

- a) Income tax Liability in respect of Appeal pending before income tax Authority for Rs. 73.71 lakh.
- b) Legal cases pending before Hon'ble Courts of India against Federation –Amount not quantifiable.

- 3-The Federation acquired Fixed Assets worth of Rs. 69,398.00 and Fixed Assets amounting to Rs. 26,397.28 has been disposed off during the year.

- 4- The Federation expended Rs. 5.95 Lakh (Rs. 17.99 Lakh) towards legal Expenses during the year to defend interest of the EFI.

- 5-Realisation of Grant/ amount receivable from Ministry of Sports/IOA, Govt of India for 17th Asian Games amounting to Rs. 1,13,99,260.11 and Amount realisation from SAI and Others amounting to Rs. 52,54,032.80 has been written off during the year. Expenses/Liability of earlier years related to 17th Asian Games amounting to Rs. 39,03,433.78 paid by players and associations has been written back during the year due to non-realisation of fund from the Govt. and other agencies.

6-The EFI has accumulated surplus of earlier years for utilisation of specific purpose. However, the same has yet not been utilised. The surplus will be added in taxable income of year in which a period of five year expired from the year it was first time created. Details thereof as under:
