
The undersigned is directed to refer to your letter No.035/EFI/2015, dated 18 Sep 2015 on the above mentioned subject.

The statute of EFI was examined & found that Para 7 Article 13, which deals with the organization and functions of Executive Committee, is not in accordance with the National Sports Development Code, 2011 and needs amendment. The interpretation of the age & tenure guidelines as per your letter is incorrect and also that the clause 7 of Article 13 relating to the age & tenure needs to be revisited.

It is also requested to you to amend your Constitution accordingly to either keep the duration of the tenure of their office bearers as four years or two years, but the number of terms allowed to an office bearer, other than a government employee, remains as specified in the Govt. guidelines. For the Govt. employees, the order of DOPT is applicable, according to which any govt. servant cannot hold elective office in any sports Federation/Association for a term of more than 4 years or for one term, whichever is less.

You are therefore, requested to amend your Constitution and submit a copy of the amended Constitution duly received by Registrar of the Society, immediately.

Subject: Annual recognition of EFI for 2017-reg

Sir,

I am directed to inform that election of office bearers of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) was held on 21.07.2013 & 27.09.2015. The result of the election of EFI was not accepted by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports in view of non-compliance of the following provisions of National Sports Development Code of India (NSDCI), 2011:

1. There should be no proxy voting in the election/AGM.
2. Government employees should hold office for one term only as per NSDCI, 2011.
3. For the Treasurer and Secretary General, there should be cooling off period after two terms as per NSDCI, 2011
4. As per EFI's constitution that office bearers can be elected & hold post for 3rd & 4th term if they secure 2/3rd majority is a violation of NSDCI, 2011.

In view of the above mentioned deviations from NSDCI, 2011, the annual recognition to EFI for the year 2017 has been withheld. EFI is advised to amend their constitution suitably to become fully compliant with NSDCI, 2011. Such amendments may be carried out as early as possible but within 3 months, failing which action would be initiated for de-recognition of the federation. Further Registrar of Societies will also be requested to withdraw permission for the use of the word "India" from the name of your Federation.

ARTICLE 008 OF STATUTES : COMPOSITION (GENERAL ASSEMBLY)

- THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN SESSION UNDER THE STATUES, IS THE SUPREME AUTHORITY OF EFI.
- THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL BE THE CONTROLLING BODY OF THE FEDERATION. ALL AUTHORITY IS VESTED IN IT AND DECISIONS OF THE ASSEMBLY SHALL BE BINDING ON ALL MEMBERS.
- EACH STATE ASSOCIATION, INSTITUTION, CLUB OR UNIT MEMBER MAY BE REPRESENTED BY ~~TWO DELEGATES~~ (ONE AUTHORISED REP) AND HAS TWO VOTES. ~~A MEMBER UNABLE TO SEND DELEGATES MAY NOMINATE AN EXISTING MEMBER TO ACT AS ITS PROXY. NO UNIT/INSTITUTION DELEGATE CAN HOLD MORE THEN ONE PROXY OF TWO VOTES IN ADDITION TO HIS OWN. AN INDIVIDUAL MEMBER HAS ONLY ONE VOTE AND CAN HOLD ONE PROXY VOTE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL MEMBER. THE PROXY (VOTING) AUTHORIZATION WILL BE SIGNED BY PRESIDENT OR SECRETARY/CO OR OC IN THE CASE OF INSTITUTIONAL/UNIT MEMBERS AND BY THE MEMBER HIMSELF IN THE CASE OF AN INDIVIDUAL MEMBER. A TERMINATED MEMBER WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REPRESENT ANOTHER MEMBER OF EFI (STATE ASSOCIATION / CLUB/INDIVIDUAL).~~

GENERAL

- AS PER STATUTES OF EFI MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ~~AND SELECTION COMMITTEE OF EFI~~, SHALL BE ELECTED IN THE GENERAL BODY MEETING/ EXTRA ORDINARY GENERAL BODY MEETING. ELECTION COMMISSION (EC)

SUBMISSION OF NOMINATION FORMS

- MEMBERS DESIROUS OF CONTESTING THE ELECTION ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT NOMINATIONS ON THE PRESCRIBED FORM, AS ATTACHED WITH THE AGM NOTICE. IT CAN BE COLLECTED FROM THE OFFICE OF THE EFI. THE SAME SHALL BE FILLED AND FORWARDED AS UNDER:-

BALLOT PAPERS

- **THE BALLOT PAPERS, ON RECEIPT, ARE TO BE CHECKED FOR CORRECTNESS. EACH BALLOT PAPER IS TO BE STAMPED WITH THE EFI ROUND RUBBERSTAMP AND INITIALED BY THE PRESIDENT/MEMBER OF THE ELECTION COMMISSION.**



ELECTIONS BYE LAWS

CANVASSING

- **NO CANVASSING IS PERMITTED ON THE DAY OF ELECTIONS WITHIN THE COMPLETE AREA OF THE VENUE OF ELECTIONS. THE CANDIDATE OR THEIR SUPPORTERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM CANVASSING IN ANY MANNER AND ISSUING ANY POSTERS, PAMPHLETS, HAND BILLS OR ANY OTHER ELECTION MATERIAL IN SUPPORT OF THEIR CANDIDATURE WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE VENUE OF ELECTIONS. THIS WILL BE SUPERVISED BY THE ELECTION COMMISSION ON THE DAY OF THE POLLING. VIOLATION OF THIS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OF THE CANDIDATE.**

PRESENCE OF CONTESTANTS OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVES

- **THE MEMBERS CONTESTING THE ELECTION OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, (ONLY EFI MEMBER) DULY AUTHENTICATED AND PERMITTED BY ELECTION COMMISSION IN WRITING, CAN BE PRESENT AT THE FOLLOWING STAGES ONLY: -**

- 3.9 The membership of the Federation should be confined to the corresponding State/UT and other special units affiliated (like Sports Control Boards etc.) and where Federation grant membership to individual clubs or individual persons, such membership does not confer on such members the right to vote in any of the Federation's meetings.
- 3.10 At the National level, there will be only one recognised federation for each discipline of sport. Only the duly recognised National Sports Federation would be entitled to financial grants as admissible. Only one State/UT Association from each State/UT shall be admitted as a member of the Federation, provided it has a minimum of 50% of the District level Associations affiliated to it. Any organisation of an all India standing and connected with the Sport may be given the status as that of a State or that of a U.T. and admitted as affiliated Member. Other categories of membership may also be given, but while each affiliated State/UT Unit shall have a right to cast vote in the General Body Meetings, no other class of Member(s) shall have any right to vote, in the Federation's meetings. While granting recognition/affiliation to a State /UT Association, the National Federation should take into consideration the representative character of the State/UT Association so as to ensure that only truly representative body of the game gets the recognition/affiliation.
