- 3. Opening Address by the President: The President welcomed all the members and expressed his desire of having the meeting more frequently. He further expressed his opinion that all should participate in the proceedings with open mind and without inhibition as this forum is basically for improvement of the equestrian sports in India. He then handed over to Secy Gen to start the proceedings.
- 4. Agenda-I: Progress on last EC Minutes Points and Passing of Minutes.
  - 4.1 <u>Formation of Telengana State Eqtn Association</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that the matter is being discussed at agenda No VI.
  - 4.2 Eventing Two Star Alongwith All Eventing Competition: The Secretary Gen informed that the same is being conducted at Bangalore wef 21 Apr 2015 to 30 Apr 2015
  - 4.3 <u>Conduct of FEI World Jumping Challenge</u>: The Secy Gen informed the house that the same will be covered under his briefing.

- 4.4 <u>Nomination of EC / Selection Committee Member's</u>: The Secretary General informed the house that the matter is being discussed at agenda No VII.
- 4.5 <u>Participation of Foreign Riders in the Indian Chapter of WCD/WJC</u>: The Secretary General informed the house that the matter is being discussed at agenda No III.
- 4.6 <u>Passing of last EC Minutes</u>: There being no further discussion on the subject, the passing of minutes was proposed by Col BS Lakra and seconded by Col Sarpartap Singh (Retd).
- 5. Agenda-II: Secretary General's Briefing.

  - 5.2 <u>All India Police Equestrian Meet 2014</u>: The Secretary General informed the house that All India Police Equestrian Meet 2014 has been conducted at Rajasthan Police Academy wef 11 to 20 Feb 2015. Police officials have requested for inclusion of police personnel as judges in future police meets. Same was turned down by the house as only FEI/EFI approved judges can judge equestrian events conducted under aegis of EFI. However, police officials can participate in clinics organized locally by EFI excluding Dressage for judging equestrian events and if found eligible can be a part of jury for police games:-

- 5.3 <u>Seminar: Dressage</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that a seminar for National Dressage judges has been planned wef 27 to 28 Apr 2015 (during CCI\*/CIC\*\*) at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore under the following FEI Officials:-

The Secretary General informed the house that the same has been put on EFI Website. The president directed that same be informed to all affiliated clubs by email.

- 5.4 <u>CSI J-B</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that an invitation has been recd from Equestrian Federation of Iran for participation of Indian Junior Team in CSI J-B scheduled wef 22 to 24 Apr 2015 at Tehran. Based on the results of JNEC 2014, the following riders have been selected:-

The Secretary General also informed the house that the foreign exposure has been approved by the Government of India on "no cost to the Govt" basis. President directed for exploration of sponsors for team if any help from EFI can be provided in form of official letter etc.

- 5.5 <u>FFI World Jumping Challenge Final to be held at Zhitnica, Bulgaria wef 02 Jul To 06 Jul 2015</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that **Ms Nadia Haridass & Mr Rushil Patel** have qualified for the final event based on the results of Cat 'A' world challenge jumping 2014. The same was applauded by the house.
- 5.6 <u>Promotion of Equestrian Sports in India / NE India</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that Mr Jean-Philippe Camboulives, FEI Solidarity Development Officer is visiting India wef 09 Apr to 12 Apr 2015 in connection with promotion / development of Equestrian sport in India / NE India. The outcome of the visit shall be intimated in next EC meeting.

5.8 <u>Court Case: Mr Angad Sahlot v/s UOI & Others</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that the matter was listed before the Hon'ble high court of Delhi at New Delhi on 09 Jan 2015 and after hearing brief arguments has disposed off the writ petition and all applications filed therewith of the writ petition (civil) No 6021 of 2014. However the Hon'ble court has kept the Crl M.A. No 17553 of 2014 pending and is now scheduled to come up for hearing on 17 Apr 2015.

Member South Region suggested that Corpus Money should be taken in advance of start of events. Secy Gen informed that same is being done but due to certain unavoidable circumstances delay in receipt of payment is there. President directed to amicably find a solution keeping in view the interest of sport.

- 5.12 17th Asian Games:- The Secretary General informed the house that :-
  - (a) Final Claim of Rs 1,13,99,260.00 (balance against total expdr of Rs 2,23,99,260.00) is still pending at Indian Olympic Association (IOA) for sanction. Regular requests/reminders are being made.
  - (b) Airfare Claim of Rs 7,49,408.00 (Rupees seven lac forty nine thousand four hundred eight only) in r/o Athletes / Officials who travelled on their own cost to Incheon & back is also pending with IOA. Regular requests/reminders are being made.

The president directed to pursue the case with concerned authority.

- 5.13 <u>State of Fund & Fixed Deposits</u>: The Secretary General informed the house about the State of fund & Fixed Deposits of this NF (Appx 'B'). Vice president (Adm) suggested to explore the feasibility of opening auto sweep savings account into FD or transfer appropriate amount into fixed deposit.
- 5.14 <u>EFI Calendar: 2014-15 (Balance Events)</u>:- The Secretary General informed the house that NEC three day event will be conducted at Bangalore wef 20 Apr 2015 to 30 Apr 2015. However, 02 eventing events which were to be held at Jaipur and Delhi could not be conducted. VP (Tech) emphasized that the imp of conduct of 04 eventing events in the interest of the rider and promotion of the sport, he laid emphasis on conduct of all 04 events as agreed in last AGM. President directed that all four eventing events will be conducted in next calendar year.
- 5.15 Col Sameer Lanba, VSM, Member Jumping brought to the notice of house that more than one medals are being given for the same event under the pretext of different names. President directed that events be promulgated in such a manner that no event to have 02 sets of prizes.
- 6. Agenda III Ruling on Foreign Rider's Participation in India for future events: Mr Kishore Futnani emphasized his views regarding participation of foreign riders as it would increase due level of competition with participation of foreign riders and would be beneficial for the sport. VP Tech clarified that there is no restriction on participation of foreign riders but they have to compete under their own flag. Mr Kishore Futnani also asked for a clarification regarding Indians taking part in competitions are Indian national. They may be holding foreign passport. House decided that in case of any discrepancy protest should be lodged to organizing committee. Majority of EC members agreed to the following u/m ruling on participation of foreign riders:-
  - (a) <u>National Equestrian Championship Events</u>: All athletes having Indian Nationality are allowed to participate in the National Championship. However a foreign rider is allowed to take part in the National Championship as a HC Entry.

- (b) <u>EFI Regional Events/Shows</u>:- Open for all riders irrespective of nationality.
- (c) <u>FEI Events (including WCJ & WCD)</u>:- Should a foreign rider based in India wish to compete in any FEI Competition (including FEI WCD & WCJ) will compete for his/her own flag and need to get his/her National Federation's permission (NOC).

After detailed discussions, Mr Kishore Futnani was not in favour about the recommended ruling on foreign rider's participation. However majority of EC members being in favour of recommended ruling, the same was agreed to and shall be passed in next AGM.

#### Article No 102.3: Eligibility of Participation: Pre Novice Horses:-(a)

FOR:-Pre Novice horses will be eligible to win a NEC medal (Individual or Team) only once after which it is automatically

RECOMMENDED:- Pre novice horses will be automatically upgraded once he achieves the following MER:-

Dressage (a) 75 Penalties

Cross Countries (b) (i) 20 Penalties & below

(ii) Not exceeding the optimum

time by over 90 secs

(b) Show Jumping 16 Penalties

A horse scoring more than 75 penalties in dressage will not be permitted to start in cross country and jumping phase of eventing.

#### Article No 104 (Para 2) :- Minimum eligibility requirement for Pre Novice & Novice One Day Events:-

#### FOR :-

(a) Dressage 67 Penalties

(b) Cross Countries (i) 20 Penalties & below

(ii) Not exceeding the

optimum time by over 90 secs

Show Jumping (b) 16 Penalties

A horse scoring more than 67 penalties in dressage will not be permitted to start in cross country and jumping phase of Eventing.

#### RECOMMENDED :-

(a) Dressage 75 Penalties

(b) **Cross Countries** (i) 20 Penalties & below

(ii) Not exceeding the optimum

time by over 90 secs

(b) **Show Jumping** 16 Penalties

A horse scoring more than 75 penalties in dressage will not be permitted to start in cross country and jumping phase of eventing.

The same was agreed to by the house.

#### 7.3 JUMPING

#### (a) Article No 207.A (Para 4): Eligibility of participation of Horses:-

#### FOR :-

Hors Concours Entry: Hors Concours (HC) entries will only be for Lower Grades and such horses will not be entitled for any benefit what so ever.

#### RECOMMENDED :-

Hors Concours Entry: Hors Concours (HC) entries will only be for Any Grades and such horses will not be entitled for any benefit what so ever.

Lt Col Rohit Dagar raised a point that during recently conducted Delhi Horse Show HC entry had not declared the grade of his horse and had participated in 02 grades.

The above proposal was not agreed to by the house and it was decided that HC entry horse participated in higher grade will not participate in lower grade. President directed that in case of HC entry grade of horse to be verified before competition.

### (b) Article No 207.A Para 1 of Note: Eligibility of participation of Horses:-

**FOR**: Horses which qualify to participate in higher grade will remain in higher grade for future competitions.

<u>RECOMMENDED</u>: Horses which qualify to participate in higher grade will remain in higher grade if the horse is placed in first three medal position irrespective of competition of one round / two rounds for future competitions.

The same was agreed to by the house.

#### (c) Article No 211 (Para 1):-

<u>FOR</u>: It is mandatory for the organizers to conduct all jumping ts competitions in all grades over two rounds irrespective of the number of entries, to enable the horses to be up graded.

**RECOMMENDED**: To be deleted.

The same was not agreed to by the house.
