## MINUTES OF 62 ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING 2023 OF EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION OF INDIA HELD ON 18 AUG 2024 AT DEFENCE SERVICES OFFICER'S INSTITUTE, DHAULAKUAN, DELHI CANTT – 110010

1. The 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual General Body Meeting 2023 of Equestrian Federation of India was held on 18 Aug 2024 at Defence Service Officer's Institute, Dhaula Kuan, Delhi Cantt. The meeting was attended by members as per details stated below: -

- 3. The Secretary General welcomed all members. He info the house that the Executive Committee (EC) of EFI had decided to hold a combined AGM for the years 2023 and 2024 but during its meeting held on 17 Aug 2024, it was decided to hold the AGM for the year 2023 only.
- 4. The Secretary General based on the request of members present read out Para 01 and 02 of Article 008 of Chapter III of EFI Statutes as which is stated below: -
  - The General Assembly, in session under the Statues, is the supreme authority of EFI.
  - ii. The General Assembly shall be the controlling body of the Federation. All authority is vested in it and decsions of the assembly shall be binding on all members.
- 5. He then info the house that the Honourable Divisional Bench of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi had reinstated the EC of EFI as it existed on 18 Dec 2019. The President and VP (Admin) of this reinstated had resigned from their respective posts. He requested the house to suggest how of proceed further.

Before the AGM Rajasthan association had taken this matter to the court. Now the court gave this order on the 7July 2023 para no. 7. It is further directed that only items notified in the agenda will be taken for consideration at the scheduled AGM and no unlisted items will be discussed. These are the court directions for the AGM which was chaired by honourable court observer Doctor Qureshi Sahib. In this paragraph number, page number 21, paragraph 5.7, it says the house unanimously agreed to the suggestions of Mr. Gaurav Joshi to the annual fee of state associations to Rs. 30,000.
